El verbo “gustar”



When you want to talk about what you like to do, use the phrase:

Me gusta + *infinitive*

Other helpful phrases to talk about what people like:

Me gusta correr. *I like to run.*

Te gusta correr. *You like to run.*

Le gusta correr. *He/She likes to run.*

¿Te gusta correr? *Do you like to run?*

¿Le gusta correr? *Does he/she like to run?*

To say someone doesn't like to do something, use *no* before the phrase.

No me gusta correr. *I don't like to run.*
